Key strands of the conference are as follows:

- History of languages and historical linguistic issues;
- The roles of mass media communication, information technology and the internet in language evolution and language shift in Vietnam and Southeast Asia;
- Dialectal and societal variation in Vietnamese and SEA languages;
- Language usage of ethnic minority languages in Vietnam and SEA;
- Issues of language status planning and language policy in Vietnam and SEA;
- The ethnic process characterized by the linguistic behaviors of Southeast Asia citizens;
